

Request for Copyright Permission: Core Knowledge[®] Foundation

FIRST, is copyright permission what you need?

If you are developing a product that uses wording from the content of Core Knowledge books, including the subject headings from the *Core Knowledge Sequence*, you should request copyright permission. If permission is granted to you, you will *within limits prescribed in the permission document itself* have the legal right to reproduce the words, phrases, or passages from the books in question and to publish and distribute your product in the specified medium and market. Without or beyond the limits of that permission, reproduction of passages from the Core Knowledge books is strictly forbidden.

If you are interested in quoting a passage from one of the Core Knowledge books in a publication of your own, you should request copyright permission. If permission is granted to you, you will *within provisions outlined in the permission document itself* have the legal right to quote a passage or passages from the books in question, subject to credit to the foundation, using language to be provided by the foundation. Without that permission, lengthy quotations of this nature (more than 100 words long) are strictly forbidden.
